Notification

No. – 6P/P.Ni.-01/2026/10745/P.R., Patna, Dated: 20/7/2026

In exercise of the powers conferred under sub-section (1) of Section 11 of the Bihar Panchayat Raj Act, 2006 (Act 6 of 2006), the Governor of Bihar hereby issues the following order for the purpose of the declaration of Gram Panchayat areas:-

Order

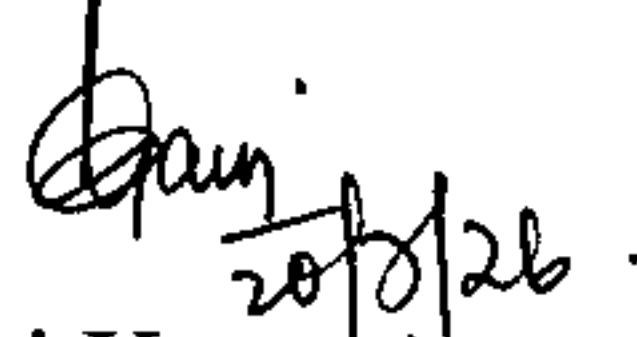
1. Under the general or special orders, directions and instructions of the State Election Commissioner, and under its direction and supervision, the District Magistrate shall declare Gram Panchayat areas for the villages situated in each block.
2. The constitution/delimitation of Gram Panchayat areas shall be carried out on the basis of the census data published in the year 2011.
3. The constitution/delimitation of all Gram Panchayat areas shall be carried out afresh according to revenue villages.
4. The block shall be treated as the unit for the declaration of Gram Panchayat areas.
5. The determination of a Gram Panchayat area shall commence from the north-west of the block and end in the south-east.
6. No village shall be split unless it becomes necessary to declare two or more Gram Panchayat areas within it.
7. Where more than one village is included, the headquarters of the declared Gram Panchayat area shall be located in the village having the majority population among the villages included in that area.

Provided that if the number of Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Backward Classes in that area exceeds 50 percent of the total population of that area, its headquarters shall be the village having the highest number (proportion) of Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Backward Classes.



8. The Gram Panchayat area shall be declared in the name of the village in which the headquarters of the Gram Panchayat is located; provided that where it becomes necessary to declare more than one Gram Panchayat area within a single village, each such area shall be declared in the name of that same village together with an indication of its location/direction.
9. In the constitution/delimitation of Gram Panchayat areas, the boundaries of the areas should, as far as possible, be natural. In addition, clearly identifiable features such as roads, railway lines and other public institutions may also be treated as boundaries.
10. The continuous monitoring of the work of constitution/delimitation of Gram Panchayat areas being carried out at the district level shall be done by the concerned Divisional Commissioner, and compliance with the guidelines issued by the State Government and the State Election Commission shall be ensured.
11. The draft determination of the Gram Panchayat area shall be published in Form-1 by affixing it on the notice board of the Gram Panchayat, the office of the concerned block, and the office of the District Magistrate, and it shall also be publicised through various means of communication.
12. After due consideration of the suggestions/objections received within 15 days from the date of publication, the District Magistrate shall determine the Gram Panchayat area.
13. The declaration of the determined Gram Panchayat area shall be made by the District Magistrate in Form-2 and published in the District Gazette.

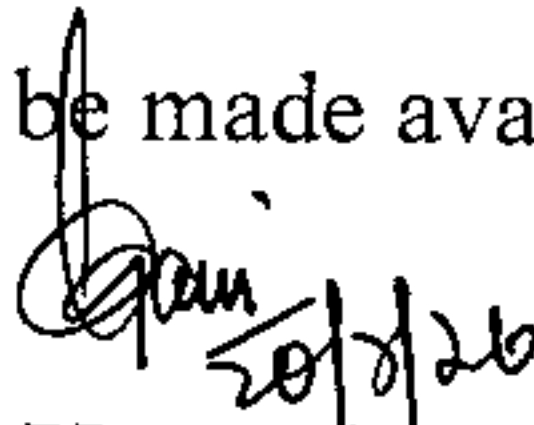

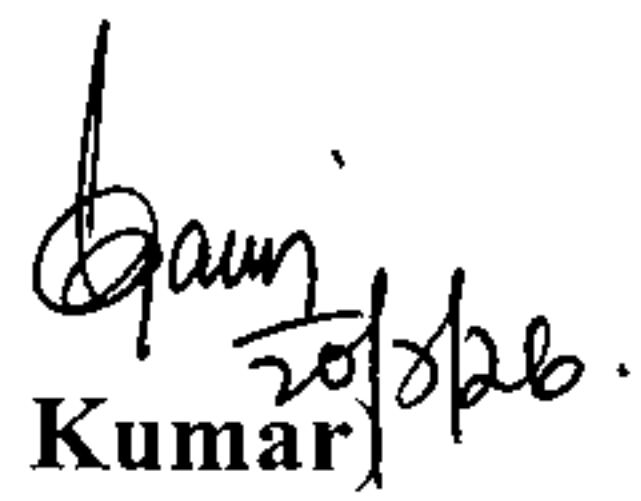
